Please obtain and review a copy of the current **Rules and Regulations** before planting. Copies are available at the cemetery office or at the website.

**Reminders**

- Dogs or other pets are considered inappropriate in a cemetery.
- There's a posted 20 mph Speed limit on our grounds.
- Please Drive Carefully.
- One Way – OKAY! - Please follow the signs.
- Park on the pavement. Never on the Grass or lawn areas.
- Respect the privacy and prayerful reflection of others.
- Chapels, benches, and flower stands are meant to be shared.
- Hours are 8am to 5pm – for your safety please adhere to this schedule.
- Do not leave your car keys or any valuables in your car while visiting, as the cemetery cannot assume responsibility for lost or stolen items.
- **How to locate your family lot?**
- Find the Section \_\_\_\_\_ Range \_\_\_\_\_ Plot # \_\_\_\_\_

In the plot from the **Interment Kiosk Directory** located near the Granny Road entrance gate.
- Locate the Section (See Cemetery Map) and Range (generally a row of graves designated as A to Z followed by AA to ZZ). Note: All locations are on the right side of each monument. In most cases, even numbered lots face one direction, odd number lots face the opposite direction.
- If there is no monument on the lot the exact location may be found either by counting along the same range from an existing monument or by lining up the lot with the same number monument in adjoining rows.
- **Choosing a decoration:** Is it reasonable and practical? Is it appropriate in size? Is it consistent with the religious nature of a catholic cemetery? If its one of a kind, leave it at home. If it's too precious to part with leave it at home. If its not meant for inclement weather, leave it at home! Keep it Simple, Elegant, Biodegradable, minimal trash at time of placement and disposal. Thank You!
- **What might be personal and special to you can be a hazard to workers** or sometimes even have an offensive or hurtful meaning to other visitors. Plant 18" in a semi-circle in front of the monument, i.e. the width or length of the monument, **not the actual lot size**.
